**BIRON MUNICIPAL WATER UTILITY WINS STATE AWARD**

PLOVER, WI – The Wisconsin Rural Water Association (WRWA) recently held its Annual Technical Conference in Green Bay, Wisconsin. Nearly 1,200 water system and water industry personnel met for four days exchanging ideas and technology through technical sessions and exhibits.

Also at this conference every year, WRWA holds a competition to pick the best Consumer Confidence Reports for all water utilities in the state. At this competition, the Consumer Confidence Report prepared by the Village of Biron Municipal Water Utilities won first place for communities under 3,300 people. This is the second year in a row the Biron Municipal Water Utility has won this award.

“As the industry evolves and the regulations on water quality and quantity increase each year, the job of keeping the public informed on the responsibilities of the water utility becomes more and more important,” said Ken M. Blomberg, WRWA Executive Director. “Customers served by Biron Municipal Water Utilities, who go above and beyond the federal requirements, should be proud of the extra effort their utility makes to keep them informed about the quality of the water they are drinking”.
