Who Should Attend?

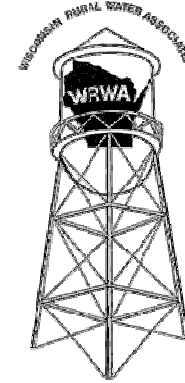

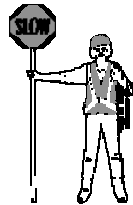
